General Club Meeting Minutes February 27, 2020

The General Meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM by President Donna Pineau at the Quality Inn, Lake Havasu City, AZ. The Pledge of Allegiance followed. Fifteen new members introduced themselves and February birthdays were acknowledged.

The board members present were: Donna Pineau, President; Linda Van Der Starre, Secretary; Leighton Kidder, Vice President; Mike O’Gorman, Treasurer and Jacki Groll, Membership Chairman. Also present were the following Chairpersons: Lynne Jackson and Laurie Reynolds, Special Events; Larry Groll, Ride Committee; Jan O’Gorman, Sunshine.

-Linda asked for omissions and corrections of the minutes. They were approved as published. She asked members to email her if there were any problems with the web site. She read the mail.

-Mike reported we have \$2,636.71 in expenses for January and income of \$5,300.30, leaving a total in the treasury of \$26,770.21. He shared the budget for 2020, detailing the projected expenses for the Board and committee chairs.

-Jacki reported we have 486 members, 44 businesses, and 10 lifetime members paid in dues. We have a total of 942 members and co-applicants.

-Guest Speaker Patti Matt, a business member from USA RV & Marine, gave us an overview of her business. She was assisted by Dawn Lindsey, Jeff and Jen. It is a 30-year local family owned business supporting “surf and turf” located at Kiowa and Lake Havasu Boulevard. They handle Boats, ATV, UTV, SXS, Golf Carts and have three bays in their service department. They also had two machines on display in front of the meeting place.

-Larry mentioned the need for each member to check out their machine before riding. This includes: trailing arms, axles, tire pressure, and springs as a start. He mentioned any street driven vehicle should have DOT approved tires. LHC officers are stopping those crossing Hwy 95 or London Bridge Road. If not DOT approved tires they can be ticketed and prevented from continuing their ride. There are CHP officers on the CA side of the lake. For those going to Havasu Landing, there is no on road travel allowed in CA. If stopped there is a \$6,000 fine and the vehicle can be confiscated for three months. Please be aware of the three classifications of rides. Private, Limited Club Ride, and Club Ride. In the future, Ride Leaders and Tail Gunners will be wearing yellow vests so they are easily identified.

-Larry mentioned the plans for the Spring Fling. There will be a leisure poker run with no time counted. The Ride Leader and Tail Gunner gift cards went to Steve Wright and Scott Piersdorff.

-The Cow Bell award went to Rick Seales for his leading 20 cars through the wildlife preserve while on the Bullhead Canyon ride.

-Lynn and Laurie reported on events. Dinner on the Boulevard will be at BlondZees on March 9.

-The Spring Fling is at Standard Wash. Set up is 3/26, and the event is Friday, Saturday and Sunday 3/27-29. Volunteers are needed. Sign up on Facebook. This is a club member only event.

-Friday will have a campfire at 5:30 with hot dogs and s’mores. Bring chairs and wood.

-Saturday will have the poker run. Raffle Tickets, Apparel sales and new member tables will be set up. Bring your own dinner, the club will furnish paper goods, dessert, and water.
