General Club Meeting Minutes October 15, 2020

The General Meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM by President Donna Pineau at The Bunker Bar, 6942 Thirsty Lizard Road, Lake Havasu City, AZ. The Pledge of Allegiance followed. Seven new members introduced themselves. We had 100+ members present.

The board members present were: Donna Pineau, President; Mike O’Gorman, Treasurer; Jacki Groll, Membership Chair; and Linda Van Der Starre, Secretary. -Linda asked for omissions and corrections of the minutes. They were approved as read and published.

-Mike reported we have a starting balance of \$27,210.44 with income of \$763.40, and expenses of \$315.00, leaving a balance of \$27,658.84 in our treasury. Donna explained the expenses were for charitable memorial donations.

-Jackie reported we have a total membership of 924 which includes applicants and co-applicants, including 41 business members and 10 lifetime members.
